

6 Tips

for Living With Wildlife



Check attics, cellars, crawl spaces, and chimneys for entry points and secure if necessary.



Trim branches away from the house, so wildlife can't access the roof.



Secure trashcans, and don't put trash out until the morning of pick-up day.



Use deterrents like music or motion-sensing lights to keep unwanted wildlife away at night.



Move brush piles away from the house, so wildlife is not encouraged to hide.



Never leave small dogs outdoors unattended. Keep cats indoors.
